## What does it offer?

**www.stolenbicycleregistry.com** allows people to list and search for their stolen bikes online. Listings are broken down by state, city, zipcode, and bike brand.



Stolenbicycleregistry.com also runs **WatchList**, a free, bimonthly email list of stolen bikes in a specific city, state, or zipcode. **WatchList** is intended to act as a quick, printable reference for people on the lookout for stolen bikes.


If you're a biking enthusiast or bike shop, **WatchList** is an excellent way to keep up on the stolen bikes in your city or community.

## How can I use it?

**If you've had a bike stolen**, you can list your stolen bike, upload photos, and even offer a reward to help recover your bike. Your contact information is kept private unless someone reports that they have found your stolen bike.

**If you come into contact with a lot of bikes**, you can register to search our listings by serial number. This feature is intended for use by serious enthusiasts, bike shops, law enforcement, or anyone else who comes into contact with a lot of bikes.

**If you are buying a used bike**, and would check to see if it's stolen, log on and take a look – or search by serial number. There might be a reward out for the bike you are looking at.



Register your stolen bike

Filing out this information will register you - and your bike - into the SBR database.

If you are wary about filling out forms, please see our [privacy policy](#). In short, we won't show your contact info unless you specify, and we won't read or misuse any of your information. The only thing we're going to do with your info is use it to notify you if someone finds your bike by running its serial number.

Once you've filled out this form, you will be emailed a password in case you'd like to come back and change your bike info.
